Ann Thomson was born in Brisbane in 1933. She studied art at the National Art School in Sydney.

Ann has had survey exhibitions at the Institute of Modern Art, Brisbane; Monash University, Melbourne; National Art School Gallery, Sydney; and Drill Hall Gallery, Canberra. She has been awarded numerous art prizes including the Wynne Prize, Geelong Contemporary Art Prize, Tattersall's Art Prize and the Canberra Times National Arts Award. Thomson's work is represented in Australian state and regional galleries.

Overseas her work is represented in many major collections including the Thyssen-Bornemisza Collection, Madrid, Spain; Villa Haiss, Zell, Germany.
